In case suit is brought upon this bond, the Surety shall pay a reasonable attorney's fee to be fixed by the court. This bond will inure to the benefit of any and all persons, companies and corporations entitled to file claim under Section 3181 of the Civil Code, so as to give a right of action to them or their assigns in any suit brought upon this bond. The Surety hereby stipulates and agrees that no change, extension of time, alteration or addition to the terms of the agreement or to the work to be performed thereunder or the specifications accompanying the same shall in anywise affect its obligations on this bond, and it does hereby waive notice of any such change, extension of time, alteration or addition to the terms of the agreement or to the work or to the specifications.
