

Recreational Vehicle (RV) Parking Standards





Who is affected?

Anyone who stores/parks their RV's, boats and trailers on residential property or city streets must abide by the City's RV parking regulations.

Where can RV's be parked on private property?

In general, RV's can only be parked in the backyard and side yard with appropriate screening. Parking and storing an RV in a front yard is prohibited.


Does the front yard restriction apply even when I am loading or cleaning my RV?

An owner may park their RV in their driveway for up to 72 hours when cleaning or prepping the vehicle for use.



EXAMPLE #1 - Side-yard storage - square residential building layout


