

Supplemental Application Requirements for Alcohol Permits

- 1. A copy of your application on file with the California Department of Alcohol Beverage Control (ABC).
- 2. A narrative description of the proposed alcohol use including:
 - A description of the business including services provided, products and food items sold.
 - Current business hours.
 - Proposed hours when alcohol will be served or sold. (alcohol sold for on-site consumption shall not be permitted within one hour of closing)
 - Whether the business operator/owner has held an ABC license in the past, the type of license, business name, location and years operated.
 - If alcohol is sold for onsite consumption, provide a food menu and indicate the hours all items on the menu are served.
 - For businesses selling alcohol for off-site consumption, whether the location is within an area of "overconcentration" and requires the City to make findings of public convenience or necessity.
 - Alcohol service training policies.
 - Two hard copies on 8.5" x 11" sheets, and one electronic copy of the narrative shall be provided.
- 3. Photographs of the interior and exterior of the establishment, provided in an electronic format. Photographs should illustrate where alcohol will be served/sold and stored.
- 4. A complete set of floor plans, dimensioned and drawn to scale, which show:
 - Interior spaces including kitchen, storage, display, restrooms and other areas.
 - Alcohol display areas.
 - Alcohol service areas such as restaurant and bar seating.
 - Location where alcohol will be stored.
 - If entertainment is proposed, floor plans must show area devoted to such uses and indicated the hours of such use.
 - Two hard copies of the plans on 11"x 17" sheets and one electronic copy shall be provided.
