
## 8 Easy Steps To Sign Up


Enter your email address and click on the "Get Started" button. You will receive an email with an activation link. Click on the link to continue setting up the account.



To register, you will need your 11-digit customer account number located on your water bill.


\*DO NOT include the dash symbol "-" when entering the account number.






Fill out the registration form. Once the form is completed, click on the "submit" button. If you provide a cell phone number, you will receive a text message with an activation code. Enter the activation code on the pop-up screen when prompted. You are now ready to log-in to your account.

Note: Password must be 8 characters long and include at least one lower, one upper case, and one number.



Enter the email address and password you used to create the account and click on the "sign in" button. You are now logged into your water meter account and can begin viewing your water usage.



On the left-hand side menu, click "Settings". A dropdown menu will appear, click "Usage Alerts" to set your alerts.

Note: An average household uses approximately 374-748 gallons of water per day when the sprinklers run that day. Please make adjustments to the "alert me when usage exceeds" setting as needed.
