"Dead Sea Scrolls Lecture" – Dr. Robert Duke, assistant professor of Biblical Studies at APU, has done extensive research on the Dead Sea Scrolls. Azusa Pacific University has acquired five Dead Sea Scroll fragments and a collection of rare biblical antiquities. APU becomes only the second institution of higher education to own original fragments from the Dead Sea Scrolls. The University is in the process of planning a special exhibit for May. Dr. Duke's presentation will focus on the background of Azusa Pacific University's acquisition of the Scroll fragments, details on the exhibit and the significance and history of the Scrolls.
