LA REGIONAL FOOD BANK DISTRIBUTION PROGRAM

The LA Regional Food Bank invites Seniors (ages 60+) to participate in the Commodity Supplemental Food Program once a month. Food Bank participants can receive a FREE food kit once per month which contains items such as canned meats, canned fruits and vegetables, dry milk, cereals, and related products. Participants must meet the following guidelines to be eligible: one person household income must not exceed \$1,383 per month, be at least 60 years of age and have a photo ID.
