May	<p>Pre-Nomination Processes</p> <p>Candidate Forum (Highly Recommended)</p> <p>Candidate Registration and Qualification Form submittal (MUST BE APPROVED BY CITY CLERK PRIOR TO SCHEDULING APPOINTMENT TO PULL PAPERS)</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Eligibility requirements: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> □ United States citizen □ 18 years or older □ Registered to voter in the City of Glendora (incorporated areas) □ Reside within the Candidate Specific Council District at the time the nomination paper is issued and for the duration of your term. • Required to start the process! <ul style="list-style-type: none"> □ Candidate should fill out a “Candidate Registration and Qualification Form” □ Submit to the City Clerk to verify eligibility to run for an Open Council seat. □ Wait for City Clerk approval! • The City Clerk will not issue a nomination paper if the candidate is not a registered voter. (California Elections Code [“E.C.”] §201.)

Candidate Registration and Qualification Form must be submitted and approved prior to an appointment being scheduled to pull Nomination Documents. • NEW! An appoints to pull papers is “Required.” • Official Nomination Papers for Glendora City Council offices can be pulled from Glendora City Clerk. • Candidates should circulate nomination petitions to gather signatures of registered voters “within their district.” <ul style="list-style-type: none"> □ Signature from voters outside their district will be considered invalid.
August	<p>Nomination Period Closes 5:00 p.m. (E-88)</p> <p>Extended Nomination Period 5:00 p.m. (E-87 through E-83)</p> <p>Withdrawal of Candidate</p> <p>Public Examination Period 5:00 p.m. (E-87 through E-78)</p> <p>Randomized Alphabet Drawing (E-82)</p> <p>Within 24 hours <i>Campaign Disclosure Election Cycle Campaign Filings August 7, 2024 – November 5, 2024 (Within 24 Hours)</i></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Last day for candidates to file nomination documents. Fax not acceptable. • If an incumbent candidate for City Council does not file, or files and does not qualify, the nomination period is extended to E-83 for only that office and for only candidates other than the incumbent. • Candidates may withdraw candidacy until 5:00 p.m. on close of nomination period. • During this period, candidate statements, candidate names and ballot designations shall be open to public examination. • The Secretary of State will conduct randomized alphabet drawing, which shall determine the order in which candidate, other than the incumbent, may file or withdraw for said office. • File with the City Clerk.

(E. C. §§ 8600 and 8601)
October 24	<p>Voting Center</p> <p>Campaign Disclosure</p> <p>2nd Pre-Election Filings, Period 9/22/24 – 10/19/24</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Opening of Vote Center at designated locations Filed with the City Clerk.

January 2025	<p>January 15 Annual payment of \$50 payment due to the Secretary of State no later than January 15. In addition to the \$50 fee, a penalty of \$150 may be assessed if payment is late.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Following the election, your duty to file campaign statements continues until your committee terminates. Reminder: In order to terminate, you must file a Form 460 with your local filing officer reporting a zero balance AND a Form 410 indicating the termination with the Secretary of State's Office and a copy with your local filing officer.
