Toddler Summer Reading Club is for children Birth through 3 years of age. During the Mother Goose Storytimes, we will model reading behaviors for parents/caregivers and children that emphasize the importance of reading to the very young. Each week we will highlight and practice one of the early literacy skills. Registration begins Monday, June 16 - Program ends Saturday, July 26.

Print Motivation - is a child's interest in and enjoyment of books.

Make reading time special – hold and snuggle as you read to your child.

*Phonological Awareness* - is the ability to hear and play with the smaller sounds in words.

Sing songs, play games and share rhymes with your child.

Vocabulary - is knowing the names of things.

Teach your child specific names of things, like vegetables at the grocery store.

Narrative Skills - is the ability to describe things and events and to tell stories.

Tell stories together, encourage pretend play, and let your child be a storyteller.

<u>Letter Knowledge</u> - is knowing that letters are different from each other and that they have different names and sounds.

Help your child identify the first letters in his/her name and find it in books, on street signs or on package labels. <u>Print Awareness</u> - is noticing print is everywhere, knowing how to handle a book and how to follow the words on a page.

Help your child discover how to hold a book and turn the pages.


